
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Warnings and Precautions

SAFETY

Important Safety Instructions

1. Read These Instructions: All safety and operations manual should be read before the product is operated.

2. Keep These Instructions: The safety and operations manual should be retained for future reference.

3. Heed All Warnings: All warnings applicable to the unit and in the operations manual should be adhered to.

4. Follow All Instructions: All operations manual should be followed.

5. Water and Moisture: Do not use this unit near water. For example, do not use near a bath tub, wash bowl, kitchen sink, or laundry tub. Do not use this unit in a wet basement or near a swimming pool or similar location. The unit shall not be exposed to dripping or splashing and no objects filled with liquids (ex: vases), shall be placed on or near this unit.




20. Wall or Ceiling Mounted: The unit should be mounted to a wall or a ceiling only as recommended by the manufacturer.







Note: Under the influence of electrostatic phenomenon, the product may malfunction and require user to reset (Press the POWER button to off unit a few minutes and turn on again).

BUILT-IN RECHARGEABLE BATTERY OPERATION

- 1. This unit operates using the built-in Lithium rechargeable battery.
- 2. Connect charging cable with micro USB output jack to connect DC input jack of main unit and other end connect to power adapter (not included)
- 3. Fully charge the built-in rechargeable battery before first use, the CHARGE INDICATOR will turn from Red to Green when the built-in battery is fully charged.
- 4. Unplug the DC INPUT jack of main unit. The unit will enter Battery Operating mode automatically.



LOW BATTERY INDICATION

- 1. When the build-in battery power low and the CHARGE INDICATOR will light Red and flash. Connect the unit to a power adaptor (not included) for charging.
- 2.After prolonged use, the battery voltage may discharge and operation might become intermittent. When this happens, recharge the internal battery.

Notes: Rechargeable batteries need to be cycled for maximum performance and longer battery life. If you don't use the player that often, be sure to recharge the battery at least once a month in order to keep the internal battery working properly.

Pairing with mobile / tablet

- 1.Press POWER button to turn on unit
- 2.Press the BLUETOOTH / USB / AUX selector to BLUETOOTH mode.
- 3. The Bluetooth Indicator will flash blue quickly, and the unit will enter pairing mode.
- 4. When pairing, remain within 3 feet of the unit.
- 5.On your Bluetooth device, select the "GQ410" in your Bluetooth settings to pair. If your device requests a password then input: "0000"
- 6.When successfully paired and connected, the Bluetooth Indicator will be light and a beep will sound from the unit.

Playing Audio Wirelessly

- 1.After pairing successful, press PLAY button / PLAY icon of external device to start playing music. Rotate VOLUME knob to desired sound level.
- 2. Press SKIP buttons of unit / external device to other track to play.
- 3.After selection, audio played through the connected Bluetooth device will now be heard through the speaker.
- 4. When USB playing, press the PLAY button once to pause mode and press the button again to resume.

USB Flash Drive Operation

This unit will play MP3 music files on a USB Flash Drive.

Install USB device with music on it

Install the USB device to USB jack

Play the USB device

- 1.Press POWER button to turn on unit
- 2.Press the BLUETOOTH / USB / AUX selector to USB mode.
- 3. Press the Play button to start playing. Rotate VOLUME knob to desired sound level

Using the skip and search function

- 1.Press the SKIP buttons to search music track.
- 2.Hold the SKIP buttons to fast search the desert track forward or rewind.

Using pause function


When USB playing, press the PLAY button once to pause mode and press the button again to resume.


Microphone

When either one or two Microphones are plugged into the MIC 1 jack / MIC 2 jack, their output is mixed with the playback from USB / Bluetooth / AUX IN Adjust corresponding MIC VOLUME knob for best balance between playback and microphone (singing) levels.




Connect External Device Using Aux-in

- 1. Press POWER button to turn on unit.
- 2. Press the BLUETOOTH / USB / AUX IN selector to AUX IN mode.
- 3. Connect audio cable to AUX-in jack.
- 4. Connect other end of audio cable to external device's audio out (headphone) jack.
- 5. The external device's audio will play on unit speaker. Rotate VOLUME knob to correct sound level.

Echo

Adjust ECHO to add depth and richness to vocals.

Balance

Adjust BALANCE can be used if MP3 file has two music channels. Normally, this would be adjusted to center, not left or right.

LED Light Show Operation

Press the LIGHT button to turn on / off LED light show on speaker grill.
