
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## Warnings and Precautions


## Setup Cradle

### Install Cradle into the unit

Install the cradle (included ) to hold the Mobile & Tablet onto unit.



Insert Personal Player / Mobile Phone / Tablet with cradle onto the unit.



### Setup – Power

#### **Connect Power Adapter**

Connect the included AC adapter into the standard AC power outlet to power the **KARAOKE MACHINE**. Connect small end to **DC INPUT** jack of main unit. After adapter connection, Press the **POWER** button to turn on / off the **Karaoke Machine**.



Built-in Rechargeable battery operation

- 1. This unit will also operate using the AC/DC Power Adaptor or built-in Lithium rechargeable battery.
- 2. Internal battery recharges when AC/DC Power Adaptor is connected to live power outlet.
- 3. Fully charge the built-in rechargeable battery before first use. The BATTERY INDICATOR will turn from Red to Green when the built-in battery is fully charged.
- After battery is charged, disconnect AC/DC Power Adaptor to enter Battery Operating mode.

#### Low Battery Indication

- 1. When internal battery is low, BATTERY INDICATOR will light Red and flash. Connect the unit to AC/DC Power Adaptor for charging.
- 2. After prolonged use, the battery voltage may discharge and operation might become intermittent. When this happens, recharge the internal battery.

Notes: Rechargeable batteries need to be cycled for maximum performance and longer battery life. If you don't use the player that often, be sure to recharge the battery at least once a month in order to keep the internal battery working properly.

## USB Flash Drive Operation

This unit will play MP3 music files on a USB Flash Drive.

### 

Install the USB device to USB jack

### Play the USB device

- 1. Press POWER button to turn on unit
- 2. Slide the DISC/ USB/ BLUETOOTH / AUX selector to USB mode. (USB not included)
- 3. Press the Play/Pause button to start playing.

### Using the skip and search function

- 1. Press the SKIP I / >> buttons to search music track.
- 2. Hold the SKIP I ◄ / ► buttons to fast search the desert track forward or rewind. Note: CDG disc not support this function.
- 3. Press the PAGE-/+ button to search PAGE of the disc.

## **Bluetooth Operation**

- 1. Press the **POWER** <sup>(1)</sup> button to turn on unit, slide the **FUNCTION** selector of **Karaoke Machine** to BLUETOOTH (BLUETOOTH mode ) position to connect your external Bluetooth device and the screen show : **BLUETOOTH (NO CONNECTION)**.
- 2. On your smartphone / Tablet, turn on Bluetooth and enable device scanning.
- 3. When unit shows **GQ450** on the Bluetooth scan, select it to connect it to your device. Notes: If cannot connect, press **UNPAIRING** button to reconnect again.
- 4. When both devices are successfully connected , The screen show :

 $\textbf{BLUETOOTH} \ (\textbf{CONNECTED}) \ , now \ you \ are \ ready \ to \ play \ music \ wirelessly \ from \ your \ device.$ 

- 5. Press the **PLAY/PAUSE** I button of external Bluetooth device to start music playback.
- Press the SKIP I < / ▶▶ of Karaoke Machine or external Bluetooth device to switch between music tracks.




## Connect External Device Using Aux-in

### AUX IN (LINE In / AUDIO In )

- 1. Connect a 3.5 mm Auxiliary Cable to the AUX-IN jack on rear of unit and to your device's audio-out (headphone) jack.
- 2. Slide the FUNCTION selector of Karaoke Machine to AUX-IN position.
- 3. Turn on both units.
- 4. The external device's audio will play on unit speaker

Please note: Disconnect AUX-in cable when using other playing functions.



## Using CD+G, CDs

### Loading a Disc

- 1. Connect power (follow SETUP POWER page).
- 2. Open the CD DOOR.
- 3. Place a CD+G or CD into the CD compartment.
- 4. Close the CD DOOR, press the POWER U button to turn on unit.
- 5. Slide FUNCTION selector to DISC position.

### Playing a Disc


- 1. Follow the instructions for Loading a Disc.
- 2. Press the PLAY/PAUSE I button to begin playing the loaded disc ( PLAY symbol will show on the screen).
- 3. Rotate the **MASTER VOLUME** dial to select the sound level.
- 4. To temporarily stop playing, press the PLAY/PAUSE ▶II button once (PAUSE symbol will show on the screen ). To resume play, press the **PLAY** /**PAUSE I** button one more.
- 5. Press SKIP Idd / D buttons to skip between next or previous tracks.
- 6. Hold the SKIP I I I buttons to fast search through the track.x

Please note: The fast-forward / fast-rewind functions will not work for CDG discs.

- 7. Connect the VIDEO OUT jack to TV, the lyrics text will show on TV.
- 8. Press the **STOP** button to stop playing.

### **Repeat Function**

- 1. Follow the instructions for Loading a Disc and Playing a Disc.
- 2. Press the **REP** button once and *c* indicator light on the screen. The unit will play the current track repeatedly.
- 3. Press the **REP** button twice and **CA** indicator light on the screen. The unit will play the entire disc repeatedly.
- 4. To cancel the repeat function: press the **REP** button repeatedly the **C** indicator light on the screen or press the **STOP** button twice to stop.



### Programming a Disc up to 20 tracks

- 1. When disc playing, press the **STOP** button to stop mode.
- 2. Press the PROG. button and the program (PROG SET) indicator will light on the screen.
- 3. Press the SKIP I I I buttons to select the track from the loaded disc you wish to play first.
- 4. Press the **PROG**. button to confirm.
- 5. Repeat steps 3 and 4 to program to play in a specified order.
- 6. Press the **PLAY**/ **PAUSE** ►II button to start the program playing.
- 7. Press the **STOP** button twice to cancel a program.

### Connecting to a Television with AV Output Jacks

This unit has AV (Audio/Video) output jacks to connect to your TV to display karaoke lyrics on your big screen. NOTE: To see lyrics, your music must be karaoke media like a CDG Karaoke disc or MP3G music file.

- 1. Connect included RCA cable to your player while matching jack and cable colors. Normally, video is yellow, right audio channel is red and left audio channel is white.
- 2. Connect the other RCA cable end to your TV's RCA input jacks. Connect proper colored cable ends to the correct input jacks with yellow, red and white colors. Note: Your TV may have different colored jacks. In that case, match video and audio jacks accordingly.
- 3. While connecting to your TV, note which input channel you chose to connect cables to.
- 4. With TV on, select the correct input source chosen in the above step.



This machine can record the music & sound while playing a CD or CD+G disc or Bluetooth when connected or an Aux Input. The recording will be an MP3 file.

- 1. Switch on **Power U** (follow SETUP POWER page)
- 2. Insert an USB flash into the USB slot at the front panel
- 3. Plug in a Microphone(s) to any Microphone jacks (Mic 1 & Mic 2)
- 4. Slide the FUNCTION switch to a selected Mode that you want to record;
- 4.1. If recording from a CD disk : Place the CD/CD+G disc onto the CD compartment and search the desired music track. Then press the **PLAY/PAUSE** ►II button to start playing;
- 4.2. If recoding from Bluetooth connection : Refer to Bluetooth Operation section for pairing, then select the music track. press the **PLAY/PAUSE** ►II button to start playing;
- 4.3. If recoding from Aux In: Connect to an external device to the 3.5mm AUX IN jack. (with the supplied AUX IN cable), then activate your device to start playing;
- 5. After the above setting procedures, press the **REC.** button to start recording and the word "REC..%"will show up on screen;
- 6. To stop recording, press the **REC.** button once;
- 7. Record Playback :


Return to FUNCTION Switch and slide to USB mode, then press the PAGE +& - to

"REC" folder playback, the last recorded song defaults in the end of the recording list. Press (SKIP I ◄ / ► ) to pick the last file which you just recorded. press (PLAY/PAUSE I)

button to start playing the recorded file.

## Microphone

When either one or two Microphones are plugged into the MIC 1 jack / MIC 2 jack, their output is mixed with the playback from USB / Bluetooth



Adjust corresponding MIC VOLUME knob for best balance between playback and microphone (singing) levels.

### Echo

Adjust the ECHO dial of Karaoke Machine to enhance your voice for a concert hall effect.

### Balance

Rotate the **BALANCE** dial of **Karaoke Machine** to hear the music and vocals or to hear the music only.

Notes: To use the **BALANCE** dial, a CD+G disc must be used. Otherwise it will operate as a standard **BALANCE** control.



Press the LIGHT button to turn on / off LED light show on speaker grill.
