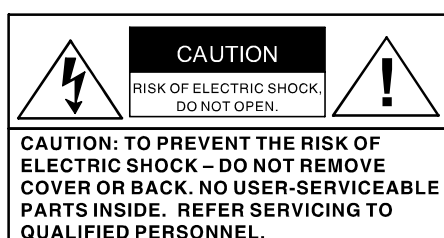

Warnings and Precautions

WARNING: To reduce the risk of fire or electric shock, do not expose this unit to rain or moisture.

Important Safety Instructions

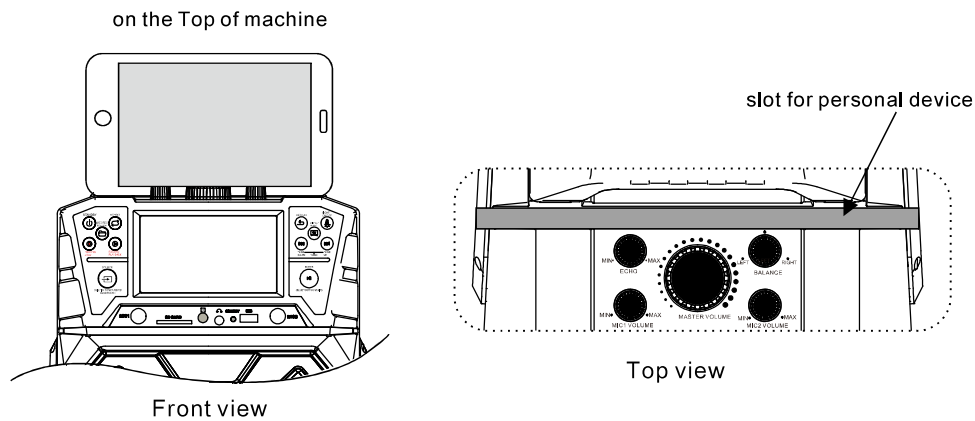


Location Controls

1. **STANDBY:** Press this button to activate machine.
2. **USB REC. FOLDER:** Folder of songs that you have recorded.
3. **RECORD/STOP:** Start and stop for record function.
4. **RECORD PLAYBACK:** Playback the recorded track.
5. **SOURCE (BUILT IN SONG/ USB/SD/BLUETOOTH):** Select the source that you wish to play.
6. **REPEAT:** Press repeatedly to set track(s) to repeat.
7. **RETURN:** Press to return to previous screen while playing.
8. **LIGHT ON/OFF:** LED Lights ON/OFF button.
9. **DISPLAY SELECT:** Press this button to switch video & audio to external TV set.(make sure the i-cable is connected)
10. **▶▶:** Next song or page.
11. **◀◀:** Previous song or page.
12. **ENTER (BLUETOOTH UNPAIR):** Play or Pause & unpair BLUETOOTH.
- 13/19. **MIC1/MIC2:** Microphone-input jack.
14. **SD CARD SLOT:** SD card reading & playback.
15. **IR:** REMOTE CONTROL Infrared receiver.
16. **HEADPHONE:** Standard 3.5mm headphone jack.
17. **STANDBY:** Power standby indicator.
18. **USB SLOT:** For playing / recording music.
20. **ECHO:** Rotate to adjust echo sound effect.
21. **MIC1 VOLUME:** Rotate to adjust volume level for MIC1.
22. **MASTER VOLUME:** Rotate to adjust level of main sound output.
23. **BALANCE:** Rotate to adjust between vocal and music mix output.
24. **MIC2 VOLUME:** Rotate to adjust volume level for MIC2.
25. **VIDEO/AUDIO OUTPUT:** Connect to TV VIDEO /AUDIO input.
26. **POWER ON/OFF:** (Master Control seesaw switch)To turn power OFF and put this machine to stand-by mode.[**Press Power button(#1) to activate machine**]
27. **DC 5V/2A:** AC Adaptor Input jack.
28. **USB CHARGER:** for charging smart devices (cell phone only).

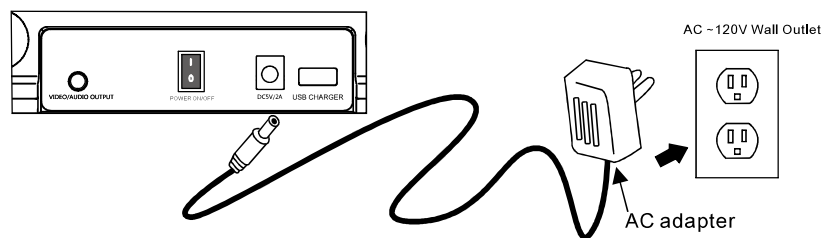

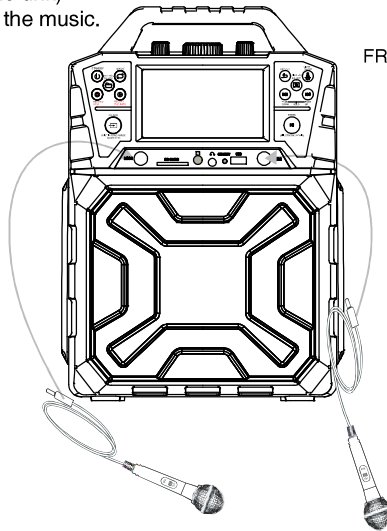

Requires microphone (included) .

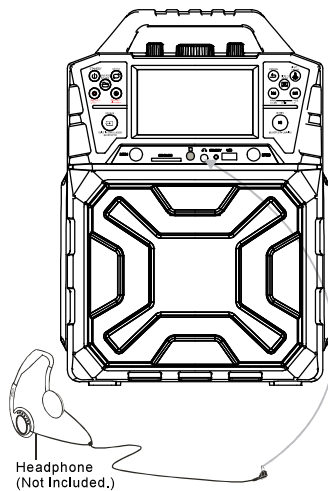
1. Plug the microphone (see below figure) into the MIC 1 INPUT or MIC 2 INPUT.
2. Slide the ON /OFF switch to ON.
3. Adjust the microphone volume to your desire level by rotating the MIC VOLUME knobs (on the top of the unit).
4. Sing along with the music.



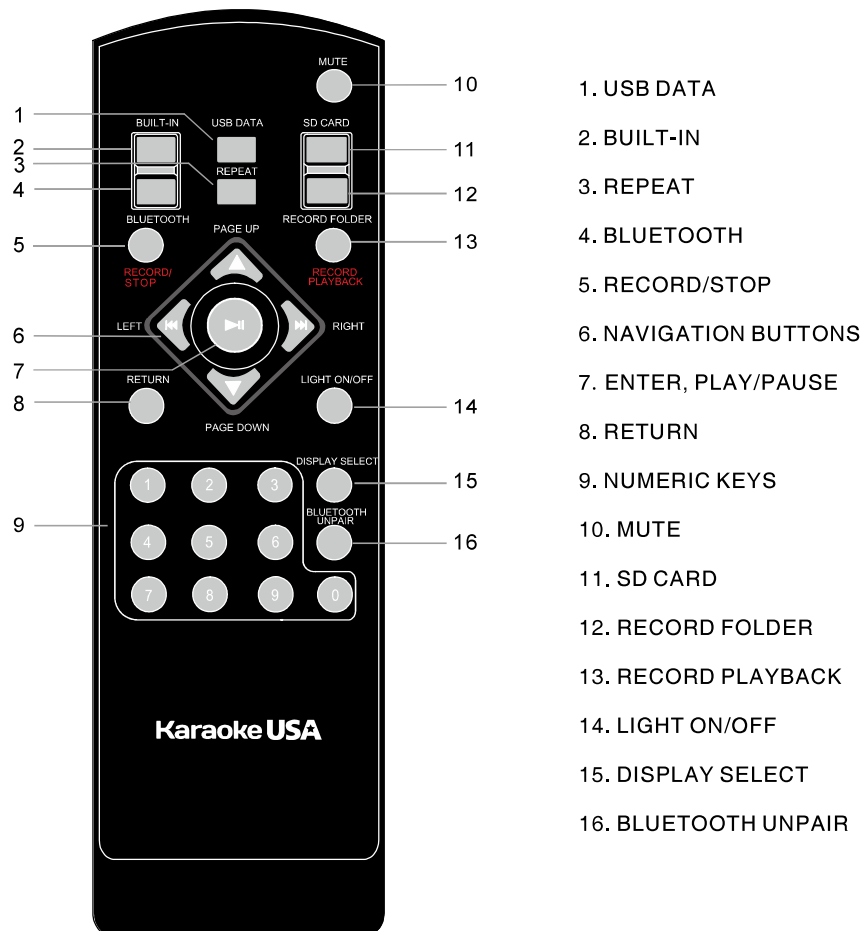
FRONT VIEW OF MACHINE









Simply connect a low impedance ϕ 3.5mm (max. 32 ohm) stereo headphone / earphone (not included) to PHONES jack of SD520. The speaker will be cut off when the headphone / earphone is plug in.

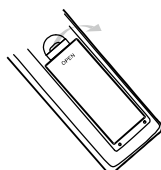
Remote Control Operations

1. USB DATA  ● Press to select media to USB mode.
2. BUILT-IN  ● Press to select Built-in songs.
3. REPEAT  ● Press this key to play selected item repeatedly.
The screen shows as below:
REP: [OFF] REP: [REP1] REP: [REP ALL]
4. BLUETOOTH  ● Press to select BLUETOOTH function.
5. RECORD  ● Record your vocal and music to the USB.
(Note: USB must be inserted before recording.)
6. PAGE UP/PAGE DOWN/
LEFT/RIGHT ● Use to navigate Up/Down and Left/Right to search for song
titles from source.
7. ENTER,PLAY/PAUSE ● To activate Play/Pause or to confirm a selected function.
8. RETURN  ● Return to a Menu screen while playing.
9. NUMERIC KEY  ● Use to specify a track number for playing.
10. MUTE  ● Press MUTE to cut off the Audio output.
Press MUTE again to resume normal Audio output.
11. SD CARD  ● Press to select SD card mode.
12. RECORD FOLDER  ● The folder that stores recorded file(s)
13. RECORD PLAYBACK  ● Press this button to playback the music that you **JUST** recorded.
14. LIGHT ON/OFF  ● To turn the LED lights ON or OFF.
15. DISPLAY SELECT  ● Press to switch from TFT color screen to TV flat screen.
16. BLUETOOTH UNPAIR  ● Disconnect existing Bluetooth function, so as to make room for
new Bluetooth connection to another device.

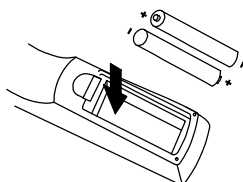

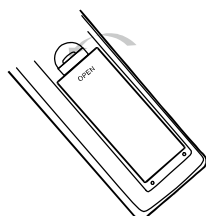

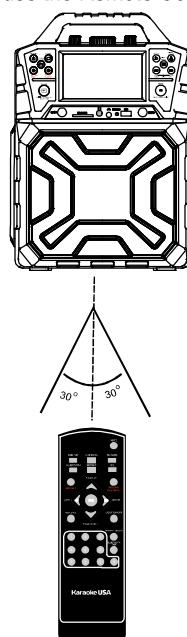

To use the Remote Control



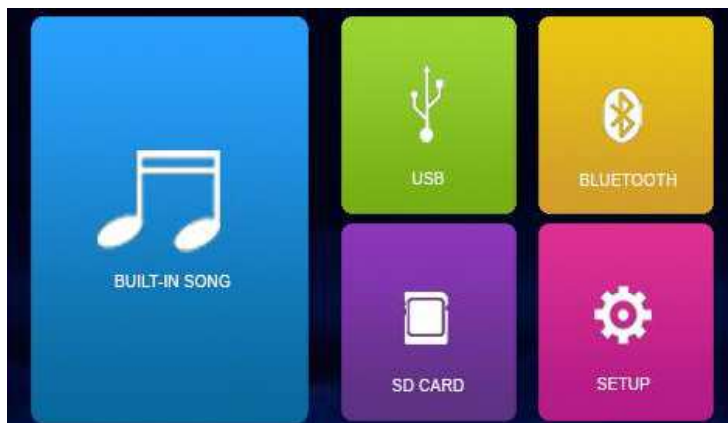
Notes:

- Point the Remote Control directly to the sensor of the machine.
- Do not leave the Remote Control in an extremely hot or humid place.
- Do not spill water or put anything wet on the Remote Control.
- When this machine will not be used for an extended period of time, please remove the Battery from the Battery Compartment.

How to Play the Machine

Press the [POWER ON/OFF] to switch ON(at the back), depress [STANDBY] button(in the front) to activate the machine.

After powering on the system, the Home Screen will display short cut icons as shown below:



① BUILT-IN SONG

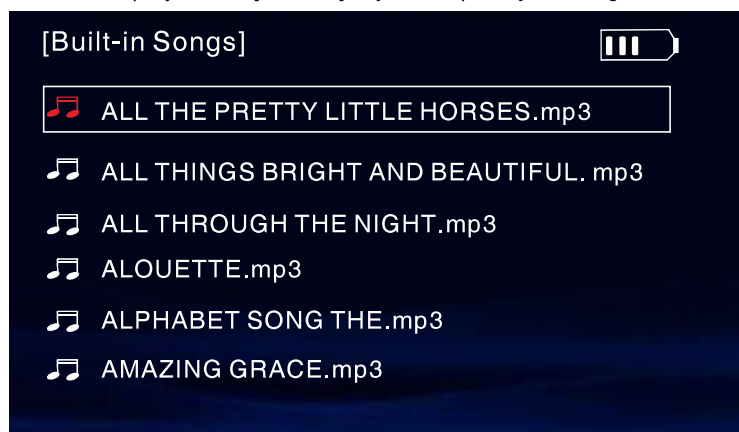
There are 2 ways to operate and playback Built-in Songs, namely by A. Machine Front Panel Control or B. Remote Control.

A. Machine Front Panel Control

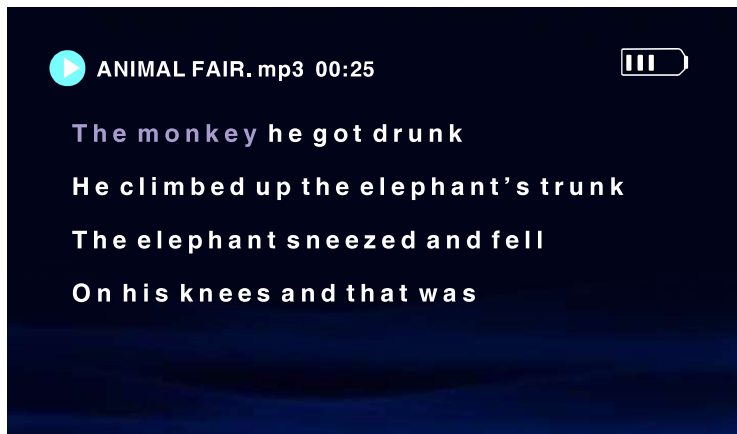
1. Depress SOURCE[Ref.page8 (#5)]button once, Built-in song mode is detected.
2. [Built- in Songs] will be displayed on the left-hand top corner of the color screen.
3. Use ◀◀ or ▶▶key[Ref.page8 (#10&11)]to scroll up or down to pick your favorite song title.
4. Follow by depressing [ENTER] key [Ref.page8 (#12)] to activate play.

B. Remote Control

1. Depress [BUILT-IN]key[Ref.page11 (#2)] to select Built-in song function.
2. Then press [NAVIGATION]buttons[Ref.page11 (#6)] to scroll the song list up or down to select your favorite song title, followed by pressing the center round [ENTER]key [Ref.page11 (#7)] to play.
3. Or use the [NUMERIC KEYS] buttons [Ref.page11 (#9)]to enter the song number you wish to play. Press [ENTER] key to complete your song selection.



How to Play the machine



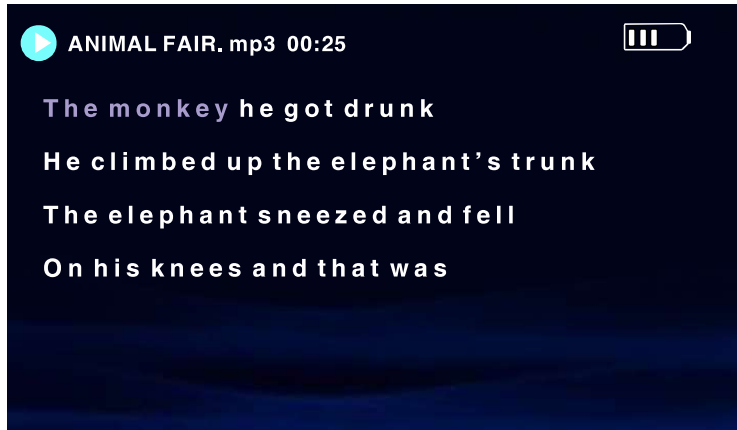
② USB Mode

1. The machine plays MP3 music that have been downloaded to your USB flash. Insert your USB flash to the USB Slot for playing.
2. Depress SOURCE [Ref. page 8 (#5)] button twice to select. A complete song list will be displayed, select your favorite song and play.

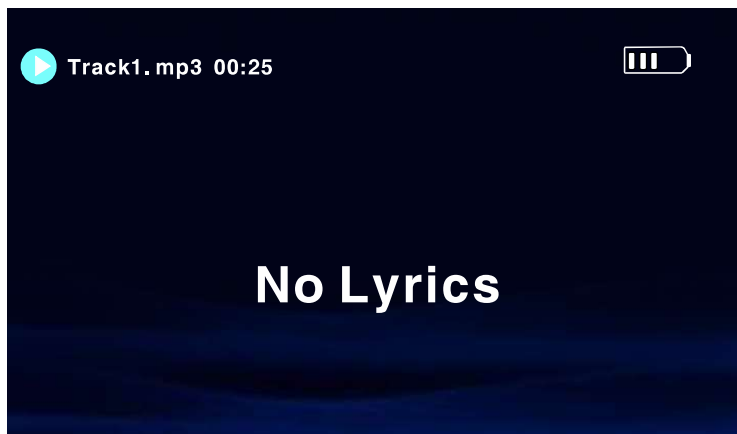


How to Play the Machine

If your downloaded music file has included graphics(MP3G), the machine will play and display lyrics on the screen as well.



Noted: If the downloaded music files are in Mp3 format, no lyrics will be displayed on screen.
[Only MP3G format downloaded song can play and display song lyrics]



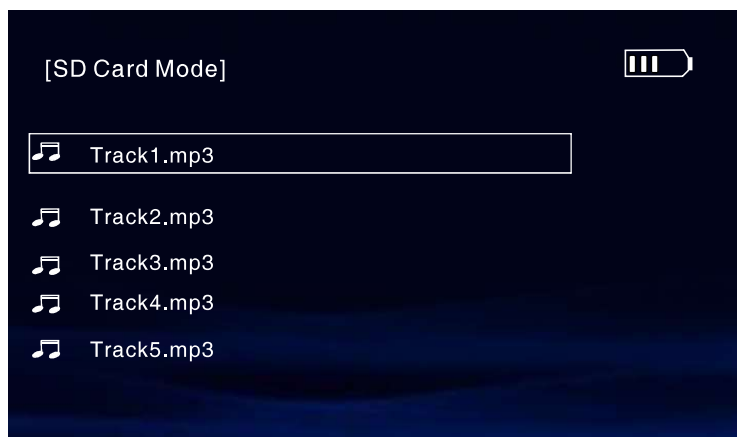
How to Play the Machine

③ SD Card Mode

This machine plays MP3 & MP3G music that were downloaded to your SD card. Just insert the SD card to the SD card slot for playing. If MP3G format was used, the lyrics of a selected song will be displayed.

[Note: Your SD card can not be used for “Recording”]

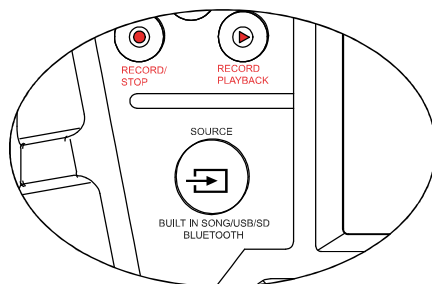
Play SD card by following the same procedures as described on ② for USB Flash.



④ Bluetooth Mode

1. Pairing Bluetooth between this machine with your Smart device :

Power ON this machine and then select Bluetooth mode on the SOURCE button.

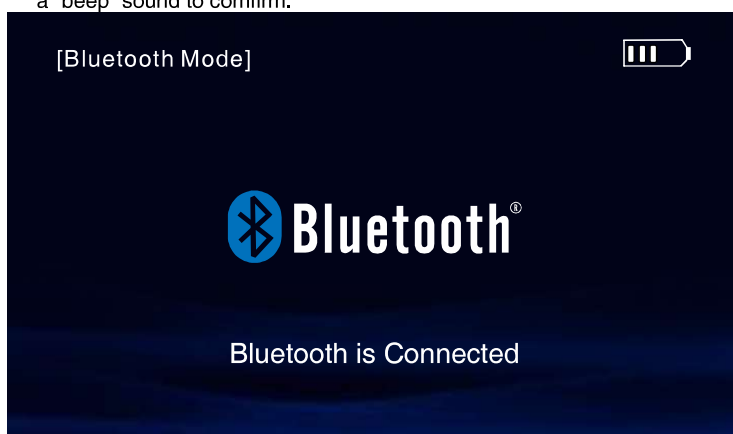


When Bluetooth is ON, the screen shows : “Please Connect Bluetooth”.

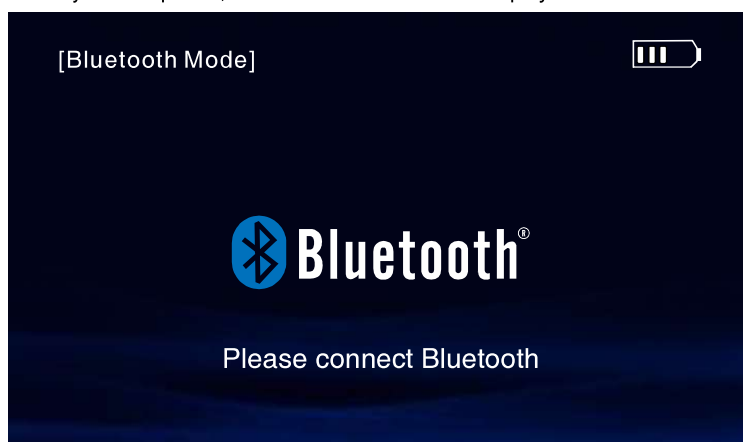
2. Setting your Smart Device to “explore”.

- A. Activate the Bluetooth searching function on your smart device.
- B. Pick the “Smart device” you want to pair.

3. Pairing your Smart Device to connect to this Machine
 - A. Your Smart Device will Discover: "Mini Karaoke".
 - B. Select Mini Karaoke to allow pairing to your Smart Device.
 - C. If they are paired, the screen will show: "Bluetooth is Connected" and you will hear a "beep" sound to confirm.



- D. If they are not paired, the screen will continue to display: "Please connect Bluetooth".







- E. Please repeat "Steps 1,2 & 3" above until they are paired.
4. Play music via Bluetooth After Pairing:
 - A. Select the song files that you wish to play from your Smart Device.
 - B. Then press "▶||" to start sending music to the Machine.
 - C. Always remember to use full volume on your Smart Device to send your song files .
 - D. Adjust the Master Volume on the Machine to a comfortable level as required.
 - E. Music will be put "on Hold" automatically when your Smart Device receives a phone call in order to let you answer. The music will resume when you end the call.
5. **Bluetooth transmits audio/music only. You cannot see lyrics displaying on the screen.**

Recording Operation

- Music source can be the built-in songs from the machine, your own USB stick, SD Card or Bluetooth connecting.
- Recorded tracks will be stored in the USB stick, under the file name "Record Folder"
- Default recording file format is MP3.
- This machine allows you to "Record" your vocal with music mix to the USB flash, please get ready by inserting a Microphone along with a USB stick to slot.

Procedures:

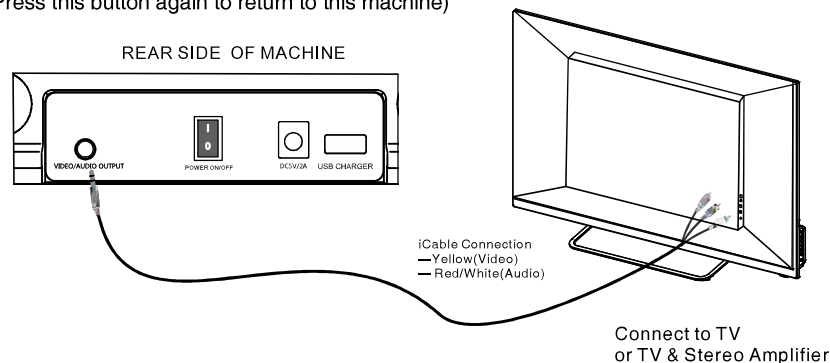
1. Plug in your Microphone, insert the USB stick;
2. Play the music;
3. Press  RECORD / STOP [Ref. page8 (#3)] to start recording;
4. Sing directly into the top of the microphone (not the side). see right picture
The microphones are uni-directional to lessen ambient interference. Sing loud and clear to the microphone;
5. When recording is done, press  to stop;
6. Press  RECORD / PLAYBACK [Ref. page8 (#4)] to listen to your recording. Or you can press  USB REC. FOLDER [Ref. page8 (#2)] to browse all your recorded files.



Connect to your home TV

You can export the lyric displaying on this machine to an external flat screen TV at your home by simply connecting the provided i-Cable.

1. Insert the RCA ends of the i-Cable with the Yellow(video), Red(audio) and the white(audio) into the matching color input jacks on the back of your big & flat color TV set.
2. Then insert the $\phi 3.5\text{mm}$ Male Jack to the Video/ Audio/Output Socket at the rear side of this machine.
3. To activate display transfer of lyrics & audio/sound to your home TV set, press the round button-DISPLAY SELECT [Ref. page8 (#9)] to proceed.
(Press this button again to return to this machine)

Troubleshooting
